- ❖ As per the New Zealand Miniature Horse Association Show Rules.
- ❖ Open to NZMHA registered horses only. A photocopy of horse's registration papers, front and back must be included with entries. If you do not own or have an NZMHA lease for the horse you are showing, then the owner must sign the entry form.

HEIGHT:

- ❖ A photocopy of a current NZMHA Height Certificate must be included with entries.
- ❖ NZMHA height for age applies.
- ❖ Certificates to be no older than:
 - Horses under three years - 3 months old
 - Horse three years and under five years – 6 months old
 - Horses Five years and over = 12 months old
- ❖ Please note: There will be no measuring on the day unless prior arrangement is made with Kirstie or Cathy. **All measuring must be completed by 8.00am.** Cost of measuring at the show is \$10 per horse except for current season's foals which shall be \$5.

GENERAL:

- ❖ All horse, exhibitors and spectators enter the grounds at their own risk. The organisers, the affiliated club or NZMHA are not responsible for any damage, injury or loss that may occur.
- ❖ No dogs on the grounds please
- ❖ Numbers to be worn on back
- ❖ No substitutions will be accepted once the show has started.
- ❖ Please be on time for your classes – once the class has been called into the ring, the steward will refuse admission to latecomers.
- ❖ No refund on entry fees unless evidence of Doctor or vet certificate (maximum 75% of entry fee)

My affinity with horses, began in my teenage years, and has resulted in very successful participation in all aspects of horse ownership, breeding, competition and judging whilst residing at my farm on the outskirts of Sydney. I acquired professional qualifications through tertiary study that support & enhance my role as a judge, mentor, talent development squad selector and competitor. I hold the Advanced Diploma in Horse Management and Certificates III & IV in Correctional Practice and have instructed TAFE Students for over 9 years in Equine Nutrition, Show Horse Preparation, Riding and Conformation & Movement. I consistently attend clinics and seminars across a variety of disciplines which enables me to increase my knowledge and skill base as a judge and rider. I have often provided my self and horse as a demonstration model for judges clinics.

Accepted onto the Australian Arabian Horse Society's Judges Panel in 1998, NSW Dressage Judges Panel in 1989, Australian Haflinger Horse Association as a Snr Classifier and Judge in 1997, NSW Pinto Horse Association and NSW Show Horse Council as a Hack & Riding class judge, I have been fortunate to judge a wide variety of shows and classes across Australia and New Zealand, These include; The Australian National Arabian Championships, National Arabian Show, Sydney Royal Show, South Australian Championships Show, West Australian Triumph Show, Victorian Classic and many other leading Arabian, agricultural and specialist shows. Visiting New Zealand twice in 2010, I had the pleasure of judging the North Island Arabian Championships at Stratford and later in the year the Mountain Miniature Horse Association Show at Hawera and have been tentatively booked for the Miniature Horse Association of New Zealand's Premier Show at Invercargill in February of 2012.

My personal equine interests lie in the fields of dressage & saddle classes where I currently compete at Elementary / Medium on my purebred Arabian Mare. I am once again looking forward to coming to New Zealand to judge your lovely horses and see some more of the spectacular country side.

I have also judged Adult and Junior Riders. I took a 2 year break from Judging whilst I had my children and have only recently started Judging again. The most recent show that I have judged at was in New Zealand at the National Show for the National Miniature Horse Society of NZ in January this year.

I have been involved with horses from a very early age. My family has a background in horses, with my Grandfather being a member of the Wollongong Hunt Club back in the 1940's and my Uncle owning, training and driving Trotters/Pacers after doing his apprenticeship under one of the top Trainers in New Zealand. I got my first pony at 7 years old and attended a week long riding camp with my pony that was conducted by Yvonne Downs when I was 10 years of age. As a teenager I also used to be my Uncle's Strapper most Friday nights at Harold Park Paceway.

I have owned and shown miniature horses for the past 10 years and I currently own a small herd of miniature horses used for breeding and showing and a thoroughbred. I have been coached in riding on my thoroughbred and have an interest in riding and dressage as well as showing the miniature horses.

I have attended a course on Equine Myofunctional Therapy and also attended a course on Barefoot Trimming. Over the past 12 years I have attended various clinics on Natural Horsemanship. I have also attended the Seminar run by IMHR & Wayne Hipsley in 2009 as well as sitting the Judges exam offered at this seminar which I completed successfully.

I have held various committee positions over the past 6 years. I have been elected to and held the positions of Treasurer, Editor and general committee member for various Miniature Horse Groups at both a State and National level. I was also on the National Show Committee for the MHAA National Show in 2010.

I have run several successful Feature Shows for various Miniature Horse Clubs. In my current position I am also in the midst of organising several Feature Shows for the Australian Miniature Horse Society (AMHS) as well as a State Show.

I am currently the National Secretary for the Australian Miniature Horse Society (AMHS) which is a new Society in Australia and I was instrumental in the formation of this Society.

Just a few of my achievements that I am proud of during my involvement in the Miniature Horse Industry are as follows:

- played a key role in getting gelding classes put on at Sydney Royal Show for the Miniature Horse breed
- Instrumental in helping bring Casey and Kelly Campbell from the USA to Australia in 2012 to conduct clinics on behalf of AMHS.

I have been a Steward at many shows including several State Shows for both Miniature Horses and Arabians and also at a National Arabian Show. I have also been a Judge Liaison at a State Show.
